Leicester park&ride

Our Park & Ride services offer a quick, easy and convenient way to travel into the city centre. The three Park & Ride sites are dotted round the edge of the city and have CCTV in operation.

Simply park up at one of the sites and hop onto the new all-electric branded buses to the city centre which run every 15 minutes.

Travel time is between 10 and 20 minutes.



Your Park & Ride service

These buses are fully electric, which means they are quieter, smoother and help keep the air across Leicester cleaner and fresher.

They also have free Wi-Fi on board to keep you connected and USB charging points to allow you to charge your phone or laptop whilst on the move.

Fares

individual day
£3.50 one person arriving in one vehicle unlimited travel all day pay the driver with cash or contactless

group day
£4 up to 5 people arriving in one vehicle unlimited travel all day pay the driver with cash or contactless

4 weeks
£45 unlimited travel for 4 weeks starts straight away longer term saver tickets can be bought from robertstravelgroup.co.uk/park-and-ride

concessions
£1 return English National Concessionary Travel Pass Holders (Elderly and Disabled) pay the driver with cash or contactless

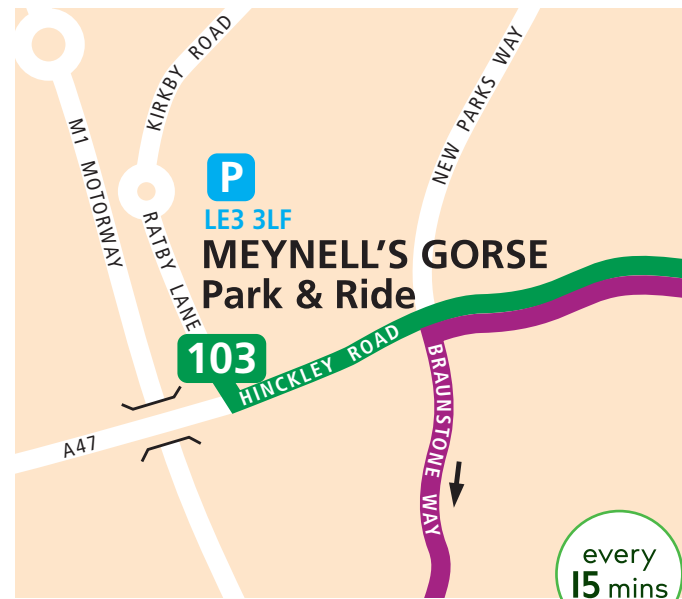

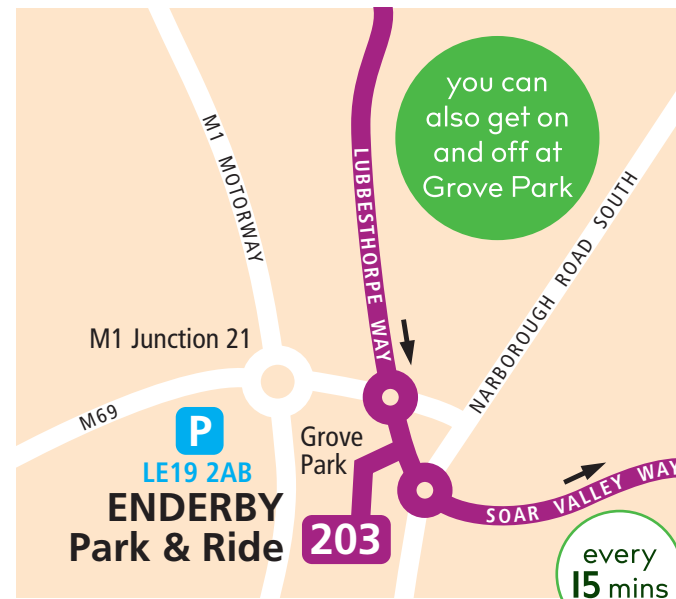

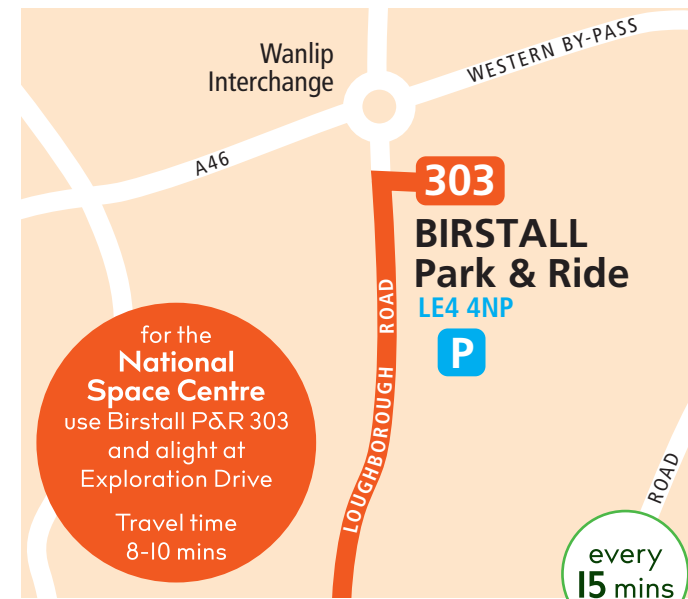
